

No-Test, DIY Ancestor Pie Chart

If you opt not to test, use this free, do-it-yourself pie chart option that's based on the child's family tree—and comes without genetic surprises:

- List all eight great-grandparents and their countries or states of origin, if known. (Or do all 16 great-grandparents or 32 third-great-grandparents).
- Tally the birthplaces and assign a color to each.
- Trace a large circle on a piece of paper. Divide the circle into eight pieshaped sections (or 16 or 32). Each section represents the birthplace of one ancestor.
- Shade each section with the assigned color and group like-colored sections together.
- Create a key defining the colors and places.
